



COVID-19 PROTOCOL CHAMPIONSHIP CLUBMATCH SEPTEMBER 19TH 2021

We are very happy to be able to organize our Championship Clubmatch, but unfortunately we still have to consider COVID-19. Despite this protocol we hope to experience a great event together with you!

* ONE METER AND A HALVE, 5 FEET! To secure the safety of the event, judges, stewards, exhibitors and visitors, the 1,5 METER / 5 FEET RULE is of the utmost importance. Give each other space to enjoy our Clubshow! Do not blame the organization if they remind you of the distancing rule when you accidentally have forgotten. After all, Nippon Inu is required to maintain this rule. A hefty fine for the club may be the result.

To prevent queues at the entrance, the secretariat and/or ring staff, the catalog will be offered online and your ring number will be sent to you by e-mail 1 week in advance to be printed at home.

- Keep your distance (5 feet) from your fellow exhibitors, the ring staff and the judge.
- The dogs will not be touched, so that the 1,5 meters / 5 feet distance can be guaranteed. You show the teeth to the judge yourself.
- The rings will have a separate entrance and exit so there will be no passing each other.
- Large classes will be judged in 2 parts.
- Don't shake hands and/or cuddle/kiss your fellow exhibitor to gratulate or to be gratulated. A bow common in Japan would be a terrific replacement!
- Do you want to take a picture with the judge? Remember the 1,5 meter / 5 feet rule!
- The club will provide some tents for shelter against rain or sun. Please bring your own garden tent if possible just in case there is no room so the 1,5 meter / 5 feet will be guaranteed.
- Events can be organized if the attendees have a fixed seat. Please bring your own chairs. We do ask of you to stay in your bubble as much as possible.
- At the secretariat / club shop and at the entrance to the canteen / toilets, we have disinfectant for you to disinfect your hands.

*FACE MASKS are not mandatory at this moment. Should this become mandatory in the near future, we will also implement this obligation.

*HEALTH RULES. Use your common sense:

- Stay at home if you or someone from your household is tested positive for COVID-19.
- Stay at home if you have been in contact with a COVID patient in the past 2 weeks.
- Stay at home if you have the following (also mild!) symptoms or have had in the past week: a cold, cough, chest tightness or fever.
- Stay at home if someone in your household has a fever and/or cold.
- If you have to cough or sneeze on the show ground, please do this in your elbow.
